



Off The Trail Campground Rules

- Limit of ONE RV or Trailer per site. Multiple tents are allowed.
- Speed Limit is 5 MPH throughout the entire campground. NO cruising or racing is allowed in the campground. Please keep our children safe!
- Quiet Time is 11pm to 7am. This is strictly enforced.
- Radios and televisions should not be heard beyond your site. No loud gatherings or parties.
- Camp Fires: Fires are permitted only in the provided fire rings. Never leave a fire unattended and extinguish the fire before retiring for the night. Supervise children at all times. Do not burn wood with nails in the wood.
- Children: Parents are responsible for their children at all times. Please do not leave children unattended. All children must be with parents at campsite by 10pm. Please be considerate of neighbors.
- Restrooms: Please remove all personal items from restrooms. Any articles left in restroom will be disposed of when restroom is cleaned.
- No Smoking: Smoking is not allowed in buildings and restrooms.
- Pets: Pets are permitted at campsites. Pets are not allowed in buildings or restrooms. All dogs must be kept on leash. Please clean up after your pet. Do not leave animals unattended. Disruptive dogs will result in your eviction.
- Fire Wood: There is NO cutting of trees or branches permitted on campground property or neighbor's properties. Wood is for sale in Campground Office.
- Trash must be disposed of at the dumpsters near Campground Office.
- Visitors: All visitors must register at office when arrive and pay visitors fee. Visitors pass includes use of all facilities and activities. Anyone who enters campground without checking in at Office will be required to leave premises immediately. You are responsible for the behavior and actions of visitors at your site.
- Insurance & Theft: Off The Trails Vacation Rentals and Campground Is not responsible in the case of theft of RV or contents thereof; nor for any damage caused by natural causes (i.e., tree falling); nor for spoilage of refrigerator / freezer foods due to loss of electricity.
- All activities in the campground are done at the individual's free will and Off The Trail Vacation Rentals and Campground is not responsible for injury to guests, or for loss of money or valuables of any kind.
- Firearms & Fireworks are prohibited in campground and anywhere on The Badlands property. This includes all types of guns, BB Guns, paint guns and ALL types of fireworks! The safety of all campers is of utmost importance.
- Alcohol is not allowed during Park Hours! Alcohol is not permitted in any common areas. Alcohol is only allowed at your campsite!
- Disruptive Behavior: Eviction from the Campground will result in eviction from the Badlands Off Road Park and eviction from the Badlands Off Road Park will result in eviction from the Campground. If the police are called by another camper or by management due to disruptive behavior, the individual will be immediately evicted from the campground, riding privileges at Badlands Off Road Park will also be terminated and all monies paid forfeited. Please do not put yourself and management in this situation.
